

## **School Aims**

The aims and objectives of our MFL curriculum are;

- For all Key Stage 2 children to receive MFL teaching during their time in KS2.
- To foster an interest in learning other language by introducing MFL in an enjoyable way.
- To develop speaking and listening skills and then later develop their reading and writing skills.
- To lay the foundations for future study.
- To follow a rough scheme of work but not too strictly and give the children a reasonable choice about what they would like to study.
- To exploit any cultural links and experiences when opportunities arise (this may be contact with a native speaker or secondary schools).
- To develop learning skills by teaching with varied teaching styles and methods whilst using an array of resources.

## **Subject content**

In the first year of studying Spanish, children will encounter the following topics:

- Culture
- Greetings
- Classroom instructions
- Animals
- Christmas
- Colours
- Opinions
- Verbs, adjectives and word order
- Numbers and age
- Days and months.
