ENGLISH

As writers, Year 1 will be using circus themed stories to inspire their writing. We are focussing on retelling stories. Year 2 writers will writing from various prompts.

MATHS

Year 1 mathematicians will focus on measuring, shape, graphs and build on numbers to 100. Year 2 will be focussing on measurement, fractions, statistics and building upon previous number work.

PE

The children will work with the Martin Gray Academy coaches each week. In Year 1 and 2 the children will be doing fitness and athletics.

SCIENCE

The scientists in Year 1 will be learning about pushing and pulling. The children will also learn about animals. Year 2 will be learning about plants and electricity.

HISTORY

As historians, Years 1 and 2 will learn facts about the circus and find out what acts were used. We will learn about Barnham.



PSHE

The children in Year 1 will be learning about how germs spread. The children will also be thinking about people who help them, such as paramedics, firemen and policemen.

GEOGRAPHY

Years 1 and 2 will be learning about where the circuses are in the world and compare it to a Non-European circus.

COMPUTING

We will begin to develop our word processing and presenting skills. We will create a poster using 2simple.
