Parent/Carer groups

We have several groups for parents, which you are welcome to attend:

Mondays: between 9am and 10am we hold a coffee morning for parents. Everyone welcome.

Wednesdays: Mrs Jafar runs a group for parents/carers wishing to improve their English. This runs from 9am to 12pm. Speak to Mrs Jafar for more details.

Thursdays from 15th November for 5 weeks there is Festive Art & Crafts course from 1:15-3:15pm in school. This is free and open to all, but booking is essential. Contact the Learning & Skills team on (01325) 405601, or text 07932 869325.

Thursdays at 11am: Nursery parents and carers are welcome into our Nursery for story-time

2 and 3 year old 'Stay and Play' session

Every Friday between 1:30pm and 3pm we have a FREE drop-in session for parents of 2 and 3 year olds to stay and play. This is run by Mrs Harper and Mrs Brennan. There is no need to book, just turn up. This is open to families outside of Corporation Road as well, so please spread the message.

Nursery and school places

If you have a child who is three years old, or turning three soon, then please ask the office for an application form. We currently have a morning session that runs 8:30-11:30am. We also have spaces in classes in other year groups.
