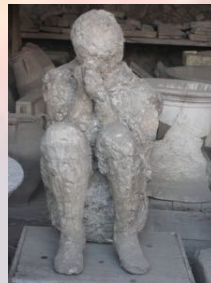
ENGLISH

PSHE

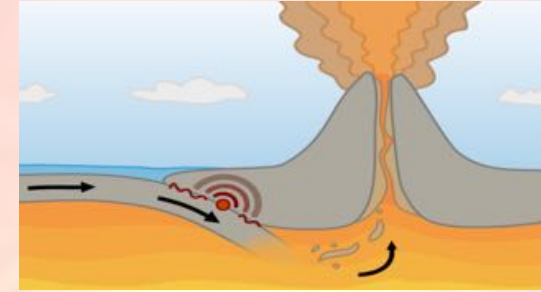
The children will be working on keeping safe around household products, being safe in the sun, dental hygiene, being healthy in exercise, body image and our own personal hygiene.
