Winter Weather

Knowledge and Understanding of the World: Animals Living in Cold Places, Winter Weather, The Importance of the Bible for Christians and children's interests.

Literacy: We will be reading books about Winter, Penguins and Polar Bears. We will describe characters, discuss story and order main events.

Mathematics: We will learn how to count objects, match these with a numeral and begin to be shown simple addition and subtraction problems.

Communication and Language: We will learn to recite Nursery Rhymes and change these to create our own funny rhymes. We will develop our ability to order and sequence events using our speech and language.



Creative: We will create models and pictures of a variety of animals using a variety of media and materials. We will learn how to create on a large scale; building igloos, ships and ice castles.

Physical Development: We will begin to hold a pencil correctly and comfortably using two fingers and a thumb. We will begin to make marks to represent letters and even words if we try!

Personal and Social Development: Children will learn how to get along with one another by solving problems, listening, sharing and talking to one another.
