

Reception - Spring 2019

Traditional Tales

CAL: Retelling stories. Acting and using expression. Speaking sentences. Using 'and' and 'because' to extend our sentences. Asking questions about stories and characters.

KUW: Looking at changes, similarities and differences in the weather and environment. Exploring ice and how it changes. Facts about Bears. Chinese New Year. Investigating materials to make a house for the 3 Pigs.

EAD: Acting out stories using props and puppets. Singing and dancing to a rhythm. Making puppets and characters. Painting and exploring colour mixing.

Literacy: We will be reading Traditional Tales. Talking about characters, events and settings in a story. Sequencing and retelling stories. Reading and writing sentences and words, letter formation, writing stories

PSED: Stranger Danger. Playing co-operatively with friends. Sharing, and being kind. Manners and respecting others property.

Mathematics: Exploring size, small, medium, large. Adding and taking away. Finding 1 less than a number. Exploring capacity. Estimation. Doubling numbers up to 5 and 10.

Physical Development: We will begin to hold a pencil correctly and comfortably using two fingers and a thumb. Scissor control. Healthy eating. Getting undressed and dressed for PE.
