### **Writing**

We have been learning about Europe in school. Read the European Landmarks comprehension text (reading lesson). Write a letter to your teacher about which landmark you would most like to visit. You could do some more research so you know more about your chose landmark. In your letter, you could include:

- An introduction to tell your teacher why you are writing to tell them which landmark you would most like to visit.
- A paragraph to tell your teacher all about the landmark you have chosen. For example, where it is (city, country, continent), how long it has been around, how tall it is etc.
- A paragraph about why you want to visit. You could use information from the text and your additional research. You could also include your knowledge

about the climate and weather in the part of Europe your chosen landmark is situated.

• A conclusion to sum up why you were writing.

When writing your letter don't forget to include the following:

- Full stops and capital letters
- Subordinating conjunctions (if, so, because, when, which, however etc.)
- A variety of sentence openers
- Prepositions (before, after, during, in, because of)
- Plus anything else you usually include in your writing.

Don't forgot to check your writing for missing words, spelling and punctuation.
