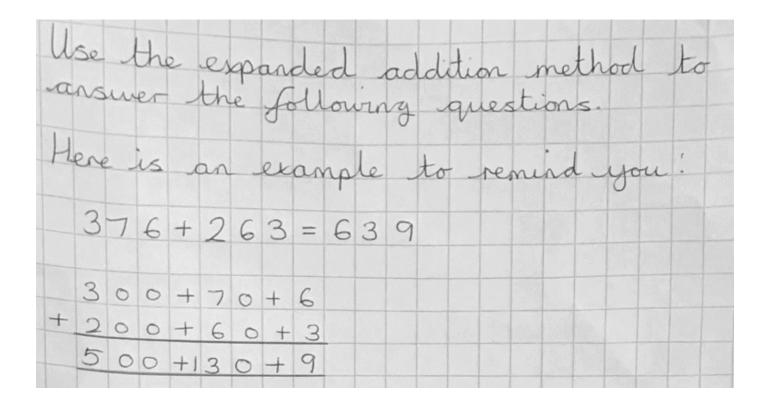
You need to practise your timetables and other number facts regularly, as we do in school.
