Calculation methods are found in the number section.

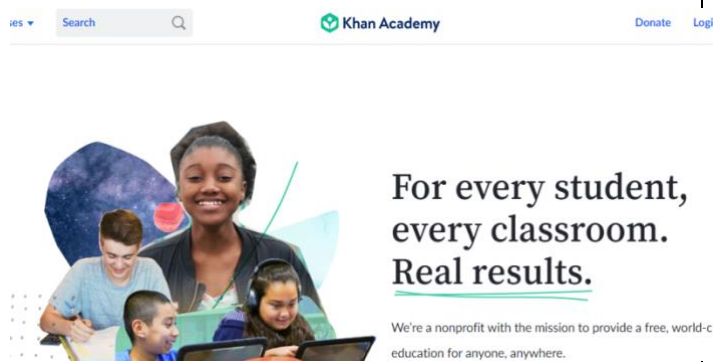
You can search for specific skills, for example long division or adding fractions, using the search box.

If you scroll down the page past the US-style grade descriptions, it is broken down into the different areas of Maths.

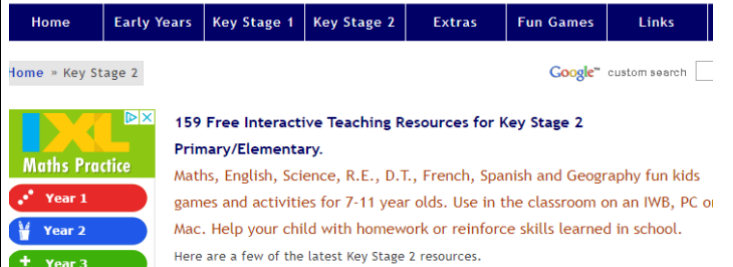

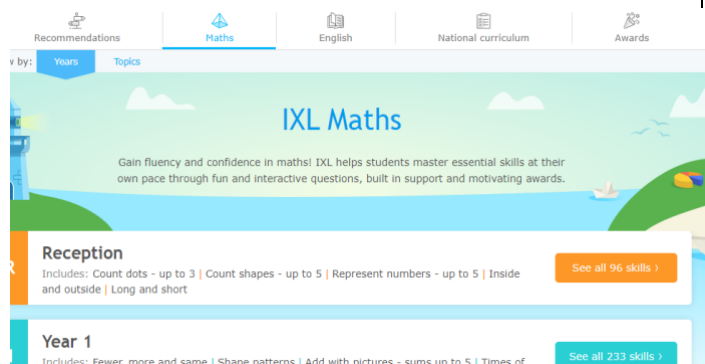

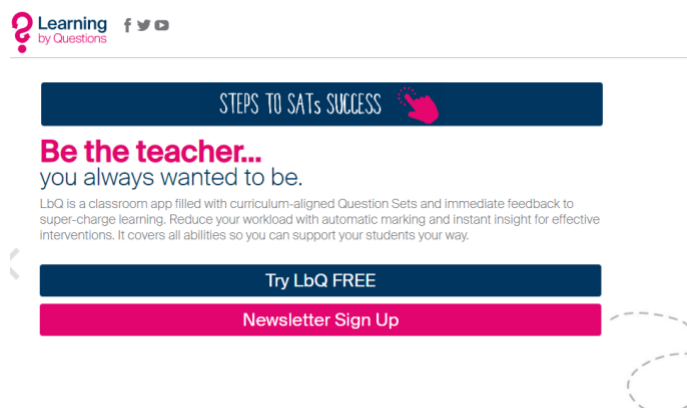
