

Spellings

This week your spelling focus is the sound /er/.

er usually appears at the end of a word.

Your spellings are: **her, over, after, ever, lower, water.**

<p><u>Read and Write</u> Read and write each word.</p> <p>See if you can join your letters together and keep them neat.</p>	<p><u>Silly Spellings</u> Be a bit silly. Write each word in different colours and sizes. Can you fill a page?</p>	<p><u>Spelling Sentences</u> Write sentences or a silly story containing your spelling words.</p> <p>Once you've done it, check that your er words are spelt correctly.</p> <p>Give yourself a 😊 if they are.</p>	<p><u>Spelling Snap!</u> Write each spelling word on a small piece of paper and turn them all over.</p> <p>Flip over a word, read it and then turn it over so you can't see it.</p> <p>Can you write the word correctly?</p> <p>Turn the card over and check. Give yourself a 😊 if you got it right.</p>
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Can you become a 'Spelling Detective' and find any of your spelling words written anywhere? You could look in books, leaflets or food labels. Can you find any more er words?

As an extra challenge, we know that the sound /er/ can be spelled in different ways. Can you find any words which have an /er/ sound that are spelt differently?
