

# Spellings

This week your spelling focus is the sound /ow/.

**ow** usually appears in the middle of a word, before an l or n or at the end of a word.

**ou** usually appears in the middle of a word and sometimes at the beginning of a word.

Your spellings are: **out, house, our, around, how, town, shower**

<p><u>Read and Write</u> Read and write each word.</p> <p>See if you can join your letters together and keep them neat.</p>	<p><u>Silly Spellings</u> Be a bit silly. Write each word in different colours and sizes. Can you fill a page?</p>	<p><u>Spelling Sentences</u> Write sentences or a silly story containing your spelling words.</p> <p>Once you've done it, check that your <b>ow</b> and <b>ou</b> words are spelt correctly.</p> <p>Give yourself a 😊 if they are.</p>	<p><u>Spelling Snap!</u> Write each spelling word on a small piece of paper and turn them all over.</p> <p>Flip over a word, read it and then turn it over so you can't see it.</p> <p>Can you write the word correctly? Turn the card over and check. Give yourself a 😊 if you got it right.</p>
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Can you become a 'Spelling Detective' and find any of your spelling words written anywhere?  
You could look in books, leaflets or food labels.
