Below are some question prompts to help you.

Ideas for writing-

- What is happening here?
- How are the panda and the child managing to fly?
- Why is the panda dropping envelopes? What is inside?
- How does Panda Post work? Write an explanation of it.

Don't forget to include:

- Full stops and capital letters
- Subordinating conjunctions (if, so, because, which, when, however etc.)
- Fronted adverbials

Don't forget to check your writing for missing words, spellings and punctuation.

Use the sentence structure steps like we do in class:

1. Say your sentence out loud
2. Count how many words are in your sentence (using your fingers)
3. Write your sentence down
4. Re-read your sentence and check for any mistakes (punctuation, spellings, missing words etc.)
