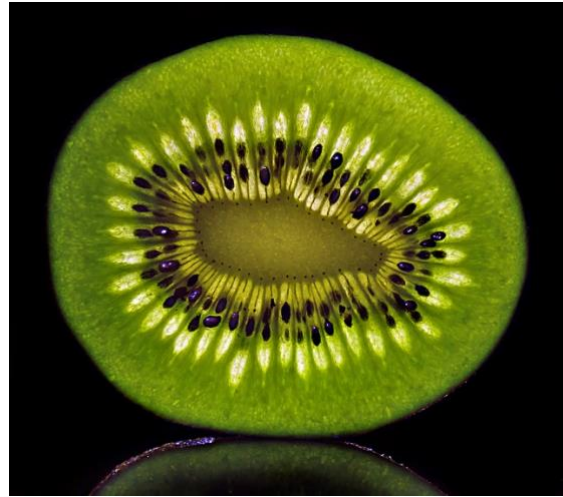



 <b>rectangle</b>	I have 4 sides. My opposite sides are equal. I have 4 corners.
