If you have children in different year groups, the child that starts second can be dropped off at the school gate, if they are entering school through the playground. They will need to stand in their lines to wait for their teacher and will not be allowed to play in the yard. If your second child is entering school through Wilkes Street, you will need to wait until the time on the letter and stay with them as there will be no one to supervise them.

It is parents and carers responsibility to socially distance outside the school gates.

Face coverings will not be worn in school and if your child wears one to get to school, parents will need to take it home. If a child comes to school alone, they will need a sealed plastic bag to store the face covering in until they leave the school premises at the end of the day.

If a parent, or carer, has a meeting in school and wears a mask in the school entrance, they will be then asked to store it in a sealed bag before entering school. Any meetings will be well organised by the school, following social distancing protocols.

Children will not bring a PE kit to school, they will be told the day they will have PE and come to school in their kit. Children will not need pencil cases and we ask that children do not bring bags to school.

At the moment, Breakfast Club will be only for those children whose parents both work. However, all children will be given breakfast in their classroom.
