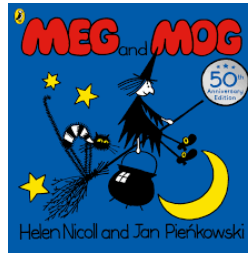
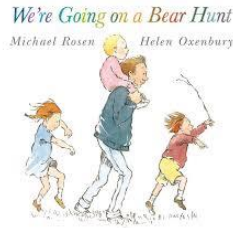


Maths

The children will count forwards and backwards within 10 as well as reading and writing numbers in numerals and words. Using equipment and mentally they will identify one more and less. Using objects and pictorial representations children will represent and compare numbers. They will explore practical and mental methods for addition and subtraction as well as learning number bonds for 10, which they will use to help solve mathematical problems.



English

Children will look at a range of texts (stories, instructions and letter writing). They will listen to and discuss these texts and think about what words mean. Children will predict what is going to happen and will discuss the sequence of events. They will learn how to form lower and upper case letters correctly. Children will orally compose a sentence before writing it with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. They will revisit graphemes learnt in Reception and be taught new ones through our phonics scheme 'Sounds Write'.



PSHCE

The children will begin the year by creating class rules to set out ways they can ensure they are following the school code of conduct. They will explore how they can contribute to life in our school by doing jobs. The children will also look at the terms fair and unfair and decide whether certain actions are fair or unfair. They will then explore emotions and how their behaviour can affect others.

Careers

This term the children will learn about jobs that people do within the community that help us including police officers, fire fighters, doctors, vets, dentists and teachers. We will have an in-class visit from one of these professionals who will talk to us about what their job entails.

History

The children will explore a range of toys that are from the past and present. The children will understand the difference between toys from the past and present. They will compare toys that their grownups played with to toys they play with now. They will be encouraged to use language and phrases linked with time. Also they will order toys by how old they are.

R.E

The children will be studying Christianity this half term. They will be learning what life is like for a Christian regarding significant people, the Bible and worship. They will also be exploring about how and why Christians celebrate Christmas.



Year 1 Autumn Term Topic/Theme: **Toys**

DT

The children will be making a toy robot. They'll explore existing products, learn cutting and joining techniques, plan, make and evaluate their own robots.

Computing

The children will learn about what technology is around us. They will begin to learn basic skills needed to use a laptop. Then they will learn how to use simple painting tools on a computer program to create digital images.

Science

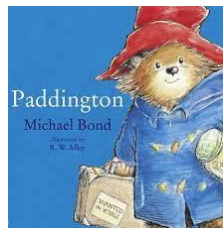
We will be studying materials this half term. The children will learn to identify them and name them. Then they will investigate their properties and how suitable they are for different purposes. We will also look at seasonal changes as we move into Autumn and Winter.

Music

The children will be learning the songs Hey You!, Rhythm in the way we walk and Banana Rap. They will be learning the basic indicators of Hip Hop and begin to understand music language such as pulse, rhythm and pitch.

Art

The children will look at the artist George Braque and use his art work to inspire their own. The children will be exploring how to use different materials to create different effects when collaging. They will learn how use a range of materials creatively to create a multimedia collage of an autumn tree.



Geography

The children will be studying and finding out about aerial maps. They will look at them and describe the human and physical features they can see. They will also create an aerial map of their own of part of the local area.

PE
