



n **Literacy** we are learnina:

- Join in with words and actions from rhyme of the week. - Features of books such as print, the illustration, front cover and pages and know text is read left to right and top to bottom.
- To join in with repeated refrain in well-known stories and know what happens next.
- To syllable clapping own name and other words.
- Rhyming and alliteration though activities.
- To copy letters from own name and letter like shapes.
- How to draw something that has recognisable features.

In Geography we are learning:

- About the local area though a walk looking for familiar features e.g. park, own house, shop.
- About travelling on the visit to the Farm notice what we see and how landscape changes.
- About maps through stories and journeys.

In History we are learning:
