

Maths

We will be learning about money, making amounts and getting change. We will also be exploring measures, including mass, length, height, capacity and temperature. We will be continuing to learn our times tables and use these when multiplying and dividing.

Geography

The children will learn about the different geographical features in our local area. They will use maps, take a walk to the local hospital and gather data about houses, buildings and shops in Darlington.

Computing

This term, the children will learn all about gathering and presenting data. They will create pictograms and block graphs. They will answer questions about the data they gather.

Science

We will be learning about animals, how they look like their parents and how they are adapted to live in their habitats. We will look at the life cycle of different animals, including humans. We will observe a caterpillar as it transforms into a butterfly.

Art

This term, the children will learn how to print using different materials. They will use their fingers, boxes, buds and foam. They will create their own piece of Art work carefully choosing their method of printing.

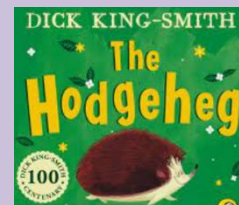
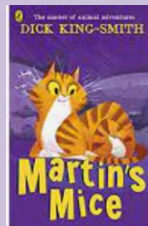
Careers

RE

Year 2 will be learning about the sacred books in different religions. They will listen to stories and identify similarities between stories found in these books.

PSHE

This term, the children will learn how they can keep their bodies clean and the benefits of doing so. They will also begin to identify what makes them unique and how we have things in common with others around us.

English

We will be retelling stories, changing parts of a story as well as writing an explanation text and a set of instructions. We will use both fiction and non-fiction texts to inspire our writing.



History

Music

This term, we will be listening to rock music and starting to learn how to compose a simple rhythm.

This term, the children will continue to learn skills needed across different sports, including jumping and passing a ball. They will also link movements together in gymnastics and portray the role of an explorer through dance.
