

Maths

We will be learning how to tell the time, looking at different ways of measuring and learning how to describe position and direction. We will consolidate our computing knowledge of tally charts when we learn how to interpret graphs and charts. Across the term we will be having lots of opportunities to practise our adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing strategies.

Geography

Children will learn about the different geographical features they would find at the seaside. They will then compare these with those features found in Darlington. They will create their own map of Saltburn.

Computing

This term, the children will have the opportunity to input instructions into BeeBots and work out how to change instructions to improve them. They will also learn about creating quizzes.

Science

We will be continuing our learning animals focussing on habitats and food chains. We will then learn about plants. This will include looking at different seeds, the conditions needed to grow a healthy plant and how plants are adapted to grow in different conditions.

Art

We will be learning how to dye materials using different food items.

Careers

Year 2 will be organising and running this years Summer fair. We will start this planning process by listening to someone, who is self-employed, talk about their job. We will then carefully plan and run the fair so look out for the date.

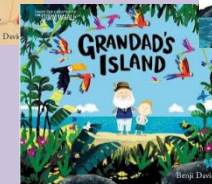
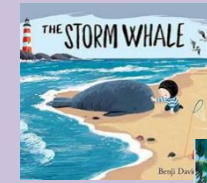
Year 2 will be learning about different celebrations and the importance of food at these special times. We will also think about how we can be better people and help others.
