Writing for a purpose and a range of audiences.

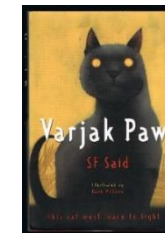
Plan and write a complete story; developing characters, setting and plot. Creating instructions.

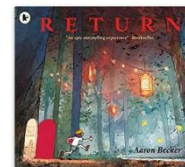
