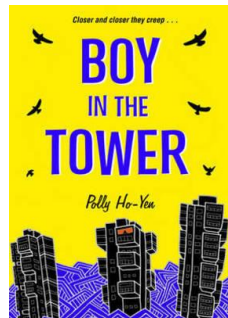




## Maths

# Year 5 Summer Term Topic/theme: River Tees/Darlington

## Geography

In geography, the children will be learning about the journey of the River Tees from source to mouth. They will also be explaining how High Force waterfall was formed and why the River Tees is important to the local area.

## R.E

Y5 will be focusing our R.E learning on what is means to be a Muslim living in Britain today. They will learn about the five pillars of Islam and their importance. Finally, they will learn about the challenges of being a Muslim in Britain today.

## DT

In D.T, the children will learn about frame structures linked to bridges. They will learn about some famous bridges and who designed them as well as explain how bridges are made and strengthened.

## Computing

In computing, the children will learn about physical computing and programming. After half term, the children will learn about selections in quizzes and learn the importance of the instruction order if, then and else statements.

## Science

In science, the children be focusing their learning on the properties and changes of materials. They will learn about how a material's property suits its role. They will learn about solutions and mixtures. Finally, they will investigate reversible and irreversible changes and give examples of both.

## Art

In art, the children will learn about the life and work of Jackson Pollock and Wassily Kandinsky. They will analyse the bold artwork of this pair and learn what perspective means in terms of artwork.

## PSHE:

In PSHE, the children will focus their learning on money matters and understanding the value of money as well as how to be a critical consumer. After half term, the children will learn about how we manage risk.

In conjunction with our PSHE topic of money matters, the children will be thinking about whether or not they should save money and what options they have to save. After half term, the children will create a presentation to their parents about the types of jobs they would like in the future.
